"BURN YOUR BOATS"

In 711, Tariq ibn Ziyad from North Africa was encouraged by the people of Spain to liberate them fro their oppressive ruler, King Roderick. Landing at Gibraltar, Tariq's army of 12,000 stood against 60,000 Spaniards, outnumbered 5:1.
