





1999 CD Football Season

The 1999 Rams, under Head Coach George Chaump, were one of the smallest Central Dauphin teams in several decades, fielding a roster of under 40 players. Though often outnumbered and outmatched, great coaching from a stellar staff paired with heart and toughness helped guide the rams to a 9-1 regular season record and a Mid Penn Commonwealth Championship. The Green and White outscored their opposition by an average score of 40-14 including a 78-7 win over rival CD East and an epic 34-27 upset of Cumberland Valley at Chapman field. The '99 season marked the Rams 4th consecutive District III playoff berth and served as a key building block in the winning tradition that Central Dauphin continues today.
