

## 2008 – 2009 Announcements

Congratulations once again to the wrestling team for bring home their 5th state championship title this past weekend. They broke the all time Pennsylvania state record with 5 consecutive state team titles. Tony Dallago and Marshall Peppelman each earned gold medals at their respective weight classes. Kenny Courts brought home a silver medal and Shyheim Brown earned the bronze medal. Simon Rice and Tyler Buckman both placed 5th and Kenny Stank brought home a 6th place medal. Once again, congratulations to the ram wrestlers for an outstanding season and a season that broke many district and state records and a season with many great memories.

Congratulations to the Varsity Wrestling Team for making District 3 history Saturday night. The ram wrestlers had eight district finalist and eight district champions setting an all time record for the number of district champions from one team in a single year. CD Wrestling was acknowledged for the 5th straight PIAA AAA Team win. Two State Champions were honored. Tony Dallago won his first State gold at 189 lbs. Marshall Peppelman won his second State Championship at 152 lbs. Additionally, Kenny Courts earned the silver medal at 160 lbs. Freshman, Shyheim Brown impressed the crowd with a third place finishes his first year in high school at 103 lbs. Simon Rice earned a 5th place finish at 119 lbs. Kenny Stank finished strong with a 6th place medal at 135 lbs. Other State Qualifiers include Kevin Gooding at 112 lbs and Tyler Buckman at 125 lbs.
